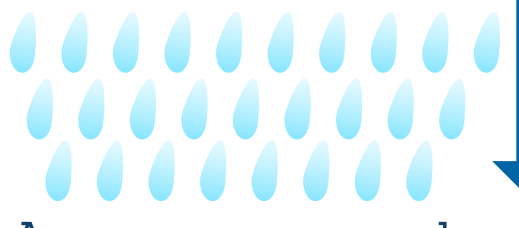
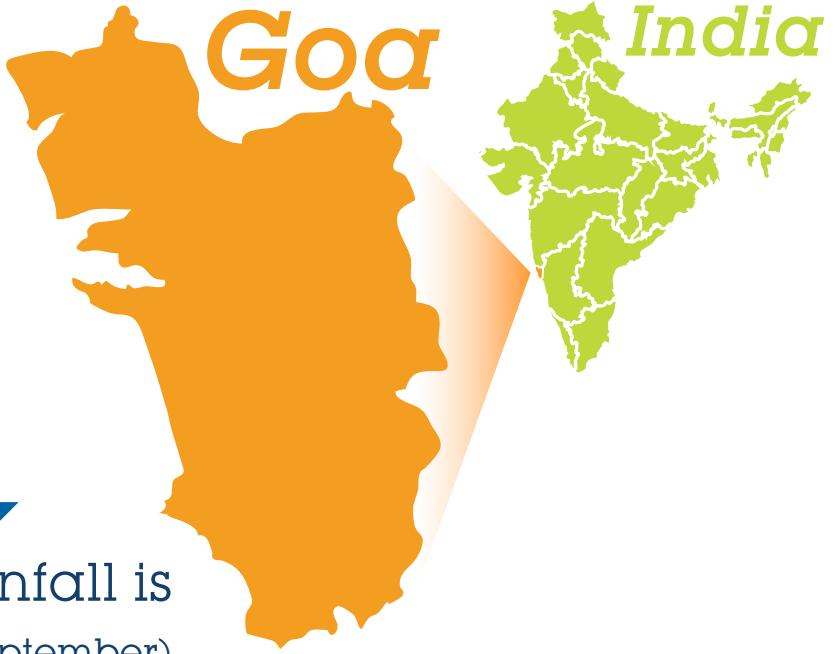


Interesting Facts about Goa

Population : **1,343,998**



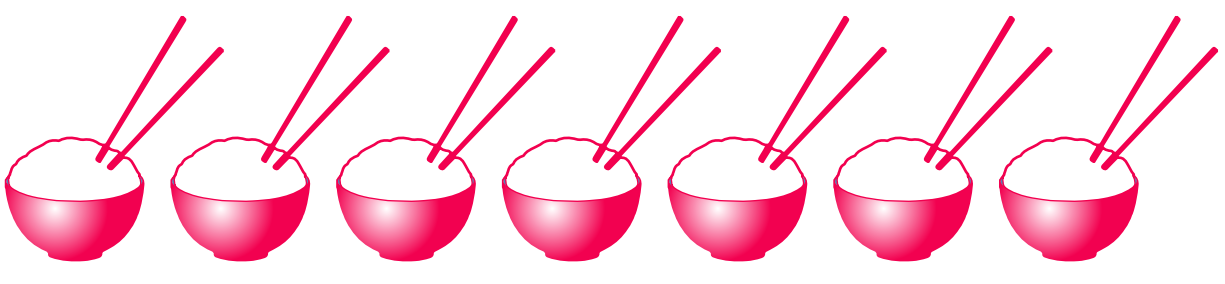
Goa is the only place where you can find a unique pillion-passenger motorcycle taxi or two wheeler taxi often referred to as a '**pilot**'.
